The Clinician: Rhonda Watts-Hettinger began riding side-saddle in 1969, participating in a wide variety of disciplines, including dressage, eventing, hunter/jumper, foxhunting, reining, gymkhana, pleasure, competitive trail, saddle seat performance, and cowboy mounted shooting. She is 5-time National Side-Saddle Champion, SSA (UK) Performance Points Supreme Champion (and many times Overseas Champion), and is the only overseas rider to have qualified for SSA's Rider of the Year Ride-Off. She is a licensed side-saddle judge and instructor (since 1981). She holds SSA's Grade 4+, "A" Instructor, and Panel Judge (R), taking those exams in the UK. She is an ARIA Level III Instructor in Side-Saddle, Riding to Hounds, and Reining, as well as a National Test Center Administrator. Rhonda is on the Board of Directors for the American Sidesaddle Association. She has taught throughout the Northeast and in the UK, and has written several books on the subject.
